Home to 24 prefabricated cabins, a 1,500-square-foot main house, and two pools, Piaule transports guests to an idyllic setting where the wilderness is transcendent. With a design done in-house and architecture courtesy of Garrison Architects, accommodations are tucked into the woods along gravel paths and adorned with untreated cedar façades set to age like the surrounding tree trunks. Western walls open to the natural splendor of the Catskills with windows crafted with overhangs that ensure rain never obstructs the breathtaking views.

tommie Hollywood

Conceived as the youthful sibling to the Thompson brand, tommie's debut in Hollywood boasts an energetic design by Studio Collective (the firm also worked on tommie's second outpost in Austin). Organic forms offset elements like the imposing steelclad fireplace in the lobby capped with a handcarved wood relief. Anchoring the 212-room hotel in its location are artworks with a distinctive California flair, including Blue Logan's mural at rooftop bar Desert 5 Spot that cheekily plays on the cowboy-themed aesthetic.
