Unbound Hotel Figueroa by Hyatt

Perks: Historical landmark, pet-friendly, midcentury pool

Spanish Colonial design influences flourish in Hotel Figueroa, a longtime fixture in Downtown Los Angeles' abundant hotel scene. While 2026 officially marks the 100th birthday for the property, the interiors are anything but dated. No matter which accommodations you choose—a standard room, upgraded suite, or high-end signature suite—expect curated art, sophisticated tilework, and modern furnishings.

50-year old cacti surround the midcentury, coffin-shaped pool, built in the 1920s, while the poolside bar, La Casita offers craft cocktails and bites. For a more substantial meal, the restaurant-in-residence Florence by the Water serves up Italian classics. Though there's plenty of tempting eateries to explore nearby as well, like the Edomae-style omakase at Bar Sawa just a 10-minute drive from the hotel. If you're looking to catch a Lakers game or concert, Crypto.com Arena is just a short walk from the property, while The Broad's contemporary art collections and the Walt Disney Concert Hall are also close by. *From \$186 per night.*
